Dear Sir/Madam,

IEC Electronic voting system

The IEC's electronic voting system, described in Administrative Circulars 79/1998 and 64/1999, has been in operation for over 2 years and over 90% of all votes and comments on technical documents are currently being submitted using this process.

The wide use of the system means that it is possible to envisage the suppression of all other voting mechanisms in the IEC. We have therefore decided that as from 2001-04-01, the IEC's electronic voting system will be the only method by which votes and comments can be submitted on technical documents in the IEC. Letters, faxes and e-mail will no longer be accepted after that date.

This advance notice is being given so that those National Committees not yet making use of the system can take the necessary steps. The Central Office will be pleased to provide advice to any National Committee that has not yet implemented procedures for making use of the electronic voting mechanism. We recommend you read [AC 79/1998](#) closely and if you have any further questions, please do not hesitate to contact Mr. Jack Sheldon (jrs@iec.ch) at the Central Office. You may also return any requests for users in your National Committee to access the voting system directly to him.
